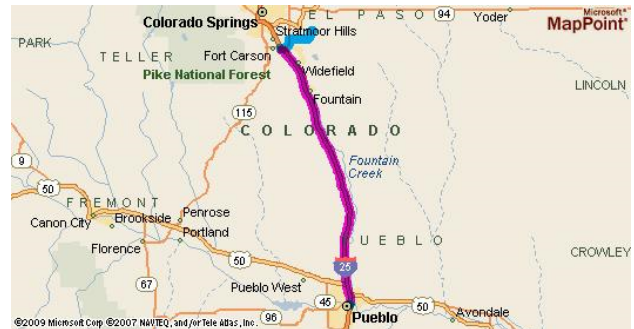

Driving directions: **(130 miles S)** Going South on I-25 Exit 98B, which is 1st street. Go off ramp on left side. Head North on I-25 Exit 98B which is 1st street, get off ramp under highway. Hotel is on the left side.
